

ACRF SEEKS APPLICATIONS FOR A MAJOR GRANT TO BE AWARDED IN 2024

In keeping with the mission of the Foundation to promote bold and significant programs that will facilitate major advances in the prevention, early detection, treatment and/or management of cancer ACRF invites applications for a special \$10 million Major Grant.

As a precursor to the Major Grant application process, Australian Cancer Research Foundation (ACRF) invites eligible persons and groups to submit a Letter of Intent (LOI).

Please refer to Major grant guidelines, which will form the basis of the full application. Please refer particularly to **criteria and expectation** sections, as the evaluation will be based on these.

The LOI serves to make the process more efficient and avoid unnecessary work producing detailed applications if the concept is not short-listed by the ACRF Medical Research Advisory Committee.

3. FUNDING REQUEST

List of equipment and where it will be located

Why this equipment and how it will be used to address purpose

Costs

Institutional support / commitment
